The amount of money we expect to receive in this financial year is £16769 plus an additional £2,756 carried forward, that we are putting towards a mile track

Provision	Total amount (approx)	Impact on the school
Teaching equipment and resources To include a daily Mile track	£13,000 – this will include the purchase of balance bikes, storage and storage for our Foundation Base and a daily mile track	Children will be fitter and in turn healthier. This will mean that their attendance will be better and they will be able to learn more. Research has shown that it brings significant improvements to their health. The purchase of the balance bikes , will aid co-ordination, balance and a sense of achievement
Attendance at and involvement in Sturminster Newton Schools Network sporting events, including coaches for transportation and educational visits involving sports and outward bound activities	£2000	Children from across the whole school will be able to participate in inter-school competitions and festivals. These include tournaments which are pathway events to Level 3 School Games competitions. All children can attend the WOEC and Leeson House residentials , to participate in new sports – kayaking, sailing, rock hopping etc
Visiting specialists, including coaches for extra curricular activities and teacher CPD opportunities	£4000	A varied range of extra curricular activities will be offered to both Key Stages. We are anticipating high take up of these places . School tag rugby and netball teams will receive targeted expert training resulting in greater success in local leagues and Level 3 School Games competitions. The status of PE across the school will stay high high as a consequence. There are now many younger children who are attending clubs because of their aspirations to be in the school teams when they are older.
